INTRODUCTION

This Cookies Policy is intended for the users of our website Bullionz.com (the “Website”). Our Website uses Cookies. Our Cookies Policy sets out what Cookies our Website collects, how we use Cookies and how you can disable cookies at any time.

WHAT ARE COOKIES

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. Cookies are widely used so as to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide certain information to the owners of a website. Cookies allow a website to identify devices used by users, personalize website functions and gather any statistical data.

When you visit and/or using our Website, we may set cookies and may also use any third party cookies to collect certain types of information automatically. Such Cookies enable us inter alia to improve our Website performance, our visitors’ experience when using our Website and to improve security and usability of our Website.

Certain of the Cookies used on our Website are session cookies which will expire when you close your browser. Other types of Cookies are persistent and as such will remain on your computer / device for an extended period of time.

WHAT COOKIES DO WE USE

In the below table, we summarise the types of cookies used by our Website, along with their purpose.

Cookie Category	Name	Purpose
Bullionz WebSite	CmsPixelRefreshCookieBody	Used to track current user page relative url and identify whether page was refreshed
BackOffice	BullionzCRMCookie	Used to identify current selected merchant in the scope of a user session
Bullionz WebSite	CountryDetectionCookieName	Used to store current client location's country code detected by IP addresscode detected by IP address

Bullionz WebSite	CookieCurrentCulture	Used to store current client culture
Bullionz WebSite	ASP.NET_SessionId	Default ASP.NET session identification cookie

You can prevent and block cookies by adjusting the settings of your browser – for instance, by activating the do-not-track feature under the “HELP” section of your browser. You may also turn off third party cookies separately through the settings of your browser.
